SGM Michael W. Glaze, the oldest of three children, was born in Frankfurt, Germany in 1960. His father was a career military NCO, and retired from the U.S. Army with the rank of Sergeant Major. SGM Glaze enlisted in the United States Army in November 1977, and completed Basic Training at Fort Knox, Kentucky, and AIT at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana. SGM Glaze then proceeded to Fort Benning, Georgia, where he graduated from Airborne School.
